ISAAC SANDERS SENTENCED TO 31 YEARS IN PRISON FOR CARJACKING AND EVADING

Deputy District Attorney Dennis Verzosa and Senior Investigator Mario Leal are pleased to announce that today, February 16, 2016, Isaac Sanders was sentenced to a substantial prison term for carjacking and evading arrest in 2012.

On December 29, 2015, a Fresno County jury found Mr. Sanders guilty of carjacking and related crimes for the theft of a car at gunpoint from Kayla Sanchez and Kim Thi Dang on December 28, 2012, in downtown Fresno.

The jury convicted 32-year-old Isaac Sanders of two counts of carjacking, assault with a deadly weapon, and felony evading of a Police Officer, as well as the allegation that he discharged the firearm during the carjacking.

Mr. Sanders was sentenced today to a term of thirty-one (31) years and four (4) months in prison.
