BERNARDO MADUENO CONVICTED OF ATTEMPTED MURDER AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE RELATED CRIMES FOR SHOOTING THE MOTHER OF HIS CHILDREN

Bernardo Madueno, Jr. (36, of Clovis) was convicted today of attempted murder and other domestic violence related crimes for the May 2015 shooting of the mother of his children in Clovis, the Fresno County District Attorney's Office has announced.

Today, a Fresno County Superior Court jury found Mr. Madueno guilty of the felony crimes of:

- 1.) Attempted Murder, along with the allegations that he caused great bodily injury during domestic violence and that he discharged a firearm during the crime that caused great bodily injury [P.C. § 664/187, 12022.7(e), & 12022.53(d)];
- 2.) Assault with a Semiautomatic Firearm, along with the allegations that he caused great bodily injury during domestic violence and that he used a firearm during the crime [P.C. § 245(b), 12022.7(e), & 12022.5(a)];
- 3.) Corporal Injury to a Spouse, Cohabitant, or Child's Parent, along with the allegations that he caused great bodily injury during domestic violence and that he used a firearm during the crime [P.C. § 273.5(a), 12022.7(e), & 12022.5(a)]; and
- 4.) Corporal Injury to a Child [P.C. § 273d(a)].

The defendant faces a potential sentence of over thirty-five (35) years-to-life in state prison when he is sentenced on May 10, 2019, at 11:00 a.m., in Department 70 of the Fresno County Superior Court. However, upon reaching age 60 and after serving 25 years, Mr. Madueno will be eligible for release under the Elderly Parole Program.
